Positive Parenting

The Triple P program is a whole "system" of support for parents because it is designed to meet the needs parents may want. From Tip Sheet discussions on a phone or Group Course, or taking individual sessions to address specific concerns, we offer a program tailored for each parent.

The Triple P program emphasis is on developing positive parenting skills to prevent problems from arising, and supports families to reach their full potential. Our approach promotes good parenting and strong relationships between parents and children.
