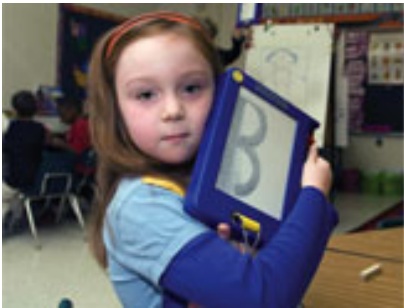


## Handwriting Without Tears

3 to 6 years



Handwriting without Tears is a research-based program that introduces fine motor skill activities for young children of all ability levels. The curriculum teaches the building blocks of letter formation and then builds on prior lessons. Letters are taught in a sequence that makes sense developmentally: in groups

of similar formation.

Through music, movement, building, coloring, and multisensory activities, children have fun as they develop important skills:

- Language proficiency
- Color and shape awareness
- Fine and gross motor control
- Letter and number recognition
- Counting abilities
- Social skills
