Loose Parts– An opportunity for children ages 2 to 6 to learn along-side their parents/caregivers about different ways to explore with open-ended materials through our interactive and hands-on activities. Loose parts can be used alone or combined with other materials. There is no set of specific directions for materials that are considered loose parts. The child is the direction.
