


We strive to support all children to gain the skills needed to achieve success in school and life and to reach their optimum development.

MISSION STATEMENT

York Child Development & Family Services Inc. ("YCD") promotes the optimum development of children through the delivery of high quality early learning programs and services and through educational and informal support to parents.

Our programs focus on the individual needs of the child as well as the needs of the group in a warm and positive atmosphere.

Our emergent curriculum is based on children's interests. We incorporate literacy, science, math, physical education, outdoor play and school readiness activities.

We foster a sense of belonging to the centre and the school, as well as the larger community in which our children live.

Parents are encouraged to become involved in the various activities of the programs to strengthen the relationship between the centre and family. In our preschool programs, we use *Storypark*® to privately share photos, videos and learning stories describing children's experiences.



Our child care centres operate fully licensed, government inspected programs.

Open Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Subsidized spaces are available through a Purchase of Service Agreement with the Region of York.

Bev Bernier Child Care Centre provides early learning and care for children 18 months to 4 years.

Crossland and Bogart Child Care Centres provide early learning and care for children aged 2 ½ to 12 years of age (the end of the school term in which the child turns 13).

Notre Dame and Stonehaven Before and After School Programs provide care for children from kindergarten to 12 years of age.

Summer Camp Programs for full day kindergarten and school aged children (grade 1 to grade 4 grads) are available.

YCD reserves the right to amend policies at any time.

NUTRITION

Good nutrition and the promotion of healthy attitudes towards food are an important part of our centres' programming.

Our full day programs provide a morning snack, lunch and an afternoon snack.

POSITIVE GUIDANCE

It is our philosophy that children's behaviour is usually a reflection of their needs. If children feel good about themselves, their behaviour will mirror that.

Positive guidance strategies are used to best meet the individual needs and developmental level of each child. Research from diverse fields of study show that children who attend programs where they experience warm, supportive relationships are happier, less anxious, and more motivated to learn than those who do not. Experiencing positive relationships in early childhood has significant long term impacts on physical and mental health, and success in school and beyond. YCD can provide parent education resources or courses for interested parents.
