### Program Descriptions

**Baby and Me** Parents, caregivers and babies are invited to join in on conversations and information sharing on healthy child development. This program includes songs, rhymes, and activities, which encourage connections with your baby.

**Creative Chefs** This program invites parents, caregivers, and children to participate in fun and interactive early learning experiences while preparing healthy and nutritious food. Resources on healthy eating and nutrition will be made available for families.

**EarlyON Circle:** A program filled with a variety of songs, tickles, and rhymes as well as story time.

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**Family Fun Outdoors** This program provides the opportunity to visit local parks and outdoor spaces. Parents, caregivers, and children can come and enjoy some fun and interactive outdoor physical activities. Studies show that children who play outdoors are happier, healthier, and smarter.

**Family Stay & Play** Parents, caregivers and children are welcome to engage in a variety of fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while providing parents and caregivers with an opportunity to connect with others.

**Fun with STEAM** This program invites parents, caregivers, and children to explore STEAM skills and concepts in a group setting. STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) learning happens everyday as children investigate, play, communicate, and try new things.

**Journey to Kindergarten** This parenting program is designed to support families with children entering Kindergarten in September. The goal is to connect participants with community resources and services in York Region and to provide a community space in which to exchange ideas, information and parenting tools that will ultimately help to establish a solid foundation in all domains of learning and will contribute to positive experiences and outcomes for children. This program includes weekly parenting sessions as well as opportunities for parent-child engagement in an intentionally-designed learning environment.

**Little Artist** Welcome to Little Artists! This program inspires the adult to nurture creative kids through easy, open-ended and fun activities. It's the kind of activities that children will want to do over and over again.

**Musical Babies:** This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and babies to experience music together. Families will gather and sing songs, learn rhymes, and use a variety of musical instruments, props, and materials.

**Nature and Me** This program welcomes parents, caregivers and children outside to explore what nature has to offer. We invite families to discover, appreciate and respect nature through discovering sights, sounds, smells and touch along the way. There may be an opportunity to see animals and wildlife in their natural environment.

**Sensory Sensations** This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children to join in fun activities that involve a range of sensory experiences. Families will have fun experimenting together using their sense of touch, sight, smell, taste, and sound.

**Sign & Sign** This program is an introduction to American Sign Language for hearing infants. The session uses songs and games as a tool to include signing in everyday routines. It is an opportunity to bond with your baby and support language development as well as attachment.

**Strollers 'n' Motion** This program highlights moving, walking, building strength, nurturing a healthy body & mind and creativity while creating an empowering community for everyBODY!

**Toddler Time** Parents, caregivers and toddlers are welcome to play together and discover the world through their senses. The nurturing environment enhances learning experiences that support healthy child development.

**Twinkle Toes** Movement is a basic and natural way which children use to learn and explore their world. This program introduces a balance of unstructured and carefully structured movement experiences to stimulate children's engagement in active, imaginative play which supports their ongoing physical, intellectual, socio-emotional and creative growth.
