Program Descriptions

Junior Gardeners - Come and explore the basic fundamentals of gardening for our little ones. With assorted gardening ideas to aid you in the spring. Held at the outdoor Community Garden at Keswick Christian Church, 2 Old Homestead Road, Keswick. Program takes place rain or shine! **This program runs the whole month of June.**

Drop-In & Play - The focus in this program is on supporting your child's learning through play. Adventure Walk - In this program we get outdoors to look for the welcome signs of spring and share conversation as we enjoy the surroundings at the ROC in Keswick on Thursday mornings. Meet in the parking area. **This program will run on June 20th and 27th only.**

Going on a Bug Hunt! - Come and join our Educator for an amazing adventure as find some interesting insects to study, and then release them back into their natural habitat. We will go on short walks searching for them. Also a special trip to the Pefferlaw river to explore some water bugs (in buckets of course) **This program runs the whole month of June.**

#StoryStretchers - Join our Educator each week for some fun and lively learning activities that heighten reading readiness and sharpen comprehension skill too. We will create crafts and sing some songs related to the stories each week.

#MorningCircle - Join our educator for a session filled with stories, songs, and a variety of activities to give you a happy start to the day!

Seamless Transitions - This interactive parent-child program is for children who are entering Kindergarten in September 2023. This six-week program focuses on nurturing the four foundations of learning; i) belonging, ii) well-being, iii) expression and iv) engagement, that children organically pursue which support optimal learning in a healthy environment.
