

Message from BOARD OF DIRECTORS
While 2022 started off with lingering closures we found life returning to some semblance of normalcy by late spring. Children were coming back to our child care programs, schools remained open and family support sessions resumed to in-person outdoor programming. Reopening occurred with some trepidation and by the fall we were no longer living with the restrictions of the past two years.

March 29, 2022, saw the historic introduction of the Canada Wide Early Learning and Child Care System (CWELCC). This system aims to decrease child care fees paid by families to an average of \$10 a day by 2025/2026, expand the number of licensed child care spaces available across the country, and increase the wage floor of RECE's in the field. Although we are excited to welcome this system, it does not come without growing pains. The province is creating a new child care funding formula that changes the predominantly self-funded model for child care into more of a government funded model. This has created some anxiety as it is extremely challenging for agencies to determine a child care budget using a funding model that is based on artificially low fees (from 2018) for income, and rising expenses following the pandemic. We highly anticipate clarity and appropriate funding to ensure programs can continue to grow and thrive.

During the early months of the year the bulk of the EarlyON Child and Family (EarlyON) programs were delivered outdoors and virtually. We opened the Newmarket site in February, with registered programs following strict cohorting protocol, followed by the Keswick site in April. By the fall of 2022 we were back in school based sites and all programs ran with no COVID limitations. The municipality implemented a brand-new region wide registration platform for families, although a hard transition, many benefits are to be found by using a portal for families to choose from so many program offerings in York Region.

The Community Action Program for Children (CAPC) resumed operation on much the same timelines the EarlyON Programs. As the reopening occurred CAPC struggled with staffing storages for the programs in the east of the region. Manpreet Bhogal left the project facilitator role at the end of the year, however, remains a part of the YCD family. Carolyn Percival returned from an evaluation role to coordinate the project, which comes naturally as Carolyn had previously held this role. We are pleased to have Carolyn back as part of the management team.

The licensed child care programs reopened mid-January and continued with cohorting and enhanced COVID protocol. By late spring restrictive protocols were removed and we had children playing in large groups, participating in field trips, and enjoying a summer program from years past. By the fall we were welcoming families back into the programs along with in person staff meetings and team building events. The introduction of CWELCC and a new sense of safety saw our programs being to fill up as demand increased for child care.

Overall, 2022 was the year that YCD, our children, families, and educators (along with the rest of the world) emerge slowly from the constraints of the pandemic. We entered the early days of 2023 reminded of the quote by Dr. Seuss "Today was good. Today was fun. Tomorrow is another one." (One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish).


- 12 regular staff on the roster and 1 EarlyON supply

We will miss the centre and Educators dearly and will always look fondly back on the time we spent as part of the family there.




NUMBER OF TIMES WE TYPED OR SAID THE WORDS COVID AND PANDEMIC





Message from CAPC Educator, Tahira Ali



I started off as a CACP mother and later became an educator. As an individual, I've experienced both sides of CAPC. Being a mother of a shy boy, how he transformed, especially graduating ST program getting ready for the mainstream world.

Being an educator, over the past 4 years we've seen families coming from different cultures/backgrounds. We have seen a drastic positive change in the behaviour of children, from shy to confident, from being hyper to getting calmer... parents have loved our programs from in-person to Virtual, specially ST program. During the pandemic, it was a challenge to reach out to our CAPC families, to check on their well-being. Introducing Live and Prerecorded Virtual Programs became really popular, especially running in different languages like English and Urdu. Over the last one year, our CAPC family has increased through word of mouth. We have seen many new families joining us, both in-person and Virtual. This year at the ST program, children who were shy, didn't talk or interact much, we saw a big change in them... Expressing themselves, talking to our educators, letting us know them much better was a positive change brought into these children. We have parents too who ask questions about different modes of behaviour treatments suitable for infants and toddlers.


















Message to STONEHAVEN B&A
